

**Art From the G.U.T.S.
7th Annual Enterprise Center Juried Student Art Exhibition**

Submission Deadline: Monday, December 12th, 2016 at 11:59 pm

The show will run from February 3rd – March 10th

Eligibility

The exhibition is open to all students enrolled in a degree program at the University of Louisiana, Monroe, Grambling State University, Louisiana Tech University, Louisiana State University in Shreveport, Centenary or B.P.C.C. Students must be enrolled for the current academic year. Students may submit up to 3 original works completed within the last two academic years while enrolled at one of the listed universities.

Deadline for Entries

All submissions must be received by 11:59 pm on December 12, 2016

Submission Requirements

Email completed entry form (.pdf available on Enterprise Center Gallery Facebook page or at <http://latechinnovation.org/exhibitions/>), submission images (up to 3), and optional artist statement to entries.gutshow@gmail.com.

Image Requirements

Image size: 1000 pixels at longest edge with a minimum of 300 resolution.
Image format: .jpg, sRGB

Name files: your name_title of work, do not use any special characters.

Example: janesmith_appletree.jpg

If work is untitled please number accordingly.

Example: janesmith_untitled1.jpg
 janesmith_untitled2.jpg, etc.

Physical works cannot exceed 5 ft in any direction with a maximum weight limit of 150 lbs. Please do not submit work that has been previously exhibited at the Enterprise Center.

Notification of Acceptance

Accepted artists will be notified, via email, by December 19, 2016, 5:00 PM.

The email address that you list on your entry form will be the address that will be used to contact you. Please use an email address that you **check regularly** as this will be our only method of contacting you.

Delivery of Works

All accepted works must be delivered to the **Enterprise Center Gallery 509 W. Alabama Ave. Ruston, LA 71270** on the following dates:

Friday, January 20th between 8 am and 5 pm

Saturday, January 21st between 10 am – 12 pm

Deliveries will not be accepted at any other time. **Late deliveries will not be included in the show.**

Presentation Requirements

All two-dimensional works must be framed (or mounted when appropriate) and ready to hang with wire cable or the equivalent attached to the back. We will not accept work with a “sticky” hanging system. Paintings on wood panels do not need to be framed, but must have proper supports. Panels will be checked for warping upon delivery.

Three-dimensional works must be delivered, completely assembled, stable, secure and ready for presentation.

If you submit work that requires assembly you must make arrangements to be present during installation to assemble it yourself.

The Enterprise Center reserves the right to omit any artwork that is not of professional quality.

Return of Works

All works must be picked up from the Enterprise Center on **Saturday, February 11th between 9 am and 12 pm**. **The Enterprise Center will not store works. Ownership of any works not picked up during the designated time will be forfeited and become the property of the Enterprise Center.**

Judging

Chris King, Professional Artist and Visual Arts Instructor at LSMSA, will serve as juror for this exhibition. He will select works based on creativity, execution and overall excellence. Exceptional work will be awarded with a prize at the opening reception.

Reception will be held on February 3rd, from 6-8pm at the Rawle Enterprise Center located at 509 W. Alabama Ruston, LA 71270.
